

# Seacoast Utility Authority has an opening for a Certified Wastewater Plant Operator

**This is a full-time, floater position**

## Purpose of Position

Performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled technical and maintenance work in the operation, maintenance and repair of the wastewater treatment facilities and systems.

## Responsibilities

Monitors all treatment processes by chemical, physical and visual analyses and adjusts operating parameters accordingly. Observes the performance of all equipment, gauges and charts in the treatment plant and pump stations. Other tasks include records statistical data relating to plant operations, troubleshoots, repairs and replaces equipment, charts lab test results for trend analysis and maintains accurate records of analyses and test results. Obtains requisite samples to evaluate treatment processes and records data from gauges and charts. Communicates to fellow operators, relief operators and supervisor's activities performed, treatment adjustments or issues encountered during shift operators. Performs housekeeping duties, yard work, painting and other general plant maintenance and repair. Will work day shift, unless evening shift or night shift personnel is absent from work, then will fill-in that position.

## Knowledge Skills & Abilities

Knowledge of wastewater plant operation and equipment;  
Two years of college or technical training in Biology, Environmental Science, Chemistry; or closely related field;  
Must be mechanically inclined;  
Florida Wastewater License C;  
Class B CDL Driver's license or ability to obtain in 6 months; and  
Florida Driver's License.
