

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

Duties include a variety of skilled and semi-skilled technical work in the operation of the Water Distribution Department.

Purpose of Position:

This position entails all of the requirements of the distribution mechanic with respect to maintenance, assessment repair and documentation appurtenances. Operate heavy equipment as necessary to provide proper maintenance and working order of the collection and distribution systems. Operates several types of power construction equipment, such as shovels, tractors, scrapers or motor graders, to excavate, move and grade earth, pour concrete or other hard surface paving materials.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Florida Driver's License in good standing.
- Florida Class B CDL or ability to obtain within 18 months.
- Required to be on-call and report for after-hours/emergency breaks.
- FDEP Water Distribution Level 3 License or the ability to obtain within 18 months.
- High school graduate or equivalent.
- Any equivalent combination of education, experience and training may be considered.
